

### **Bright Lights**

Trap Machine Usage Reminders

DO NOT ADJUST TRAP MACHINES!

- Trap machines are set to the standard 42-44 mph. They throw faster as they get to the bottom. Do not change the speed please.
- 2. IMPORTANT! Must not leave the oscillator turned off. Builds up pressure on the thrower. Please leave the machine set on oscillating. If you use straight away, turn back to oscillating when you are done.
- 3. Trajectory is set for Bright lights Monday. If you change the angle, please put it back to standard setting.

<u>Hand Thrower Area</u>: Members, groups, and guest are responsible for picking up shells and emptying shell buckets in the blue dumpster. Break down your boxes and put in blue dumpster. Turn off lights and ceiling fan after use. Put stands and throwers back in order.

\*\*If houses and traps are not kept cleaned after use, cords will be removed until houses, traps, and fields are detailed.

SIGN IN UPON ARRIVAL. Note: Proper cord storage. 3' Loops, not twisted. Put all trash (hulls, boxes, etc...) in blue dumpster. If you have a group or guest, you "the member", are responsible for counts, cleanup, payment, and such.

# <u>General Meeting Minutes – December, 2020</u>

December Meeting was cancelled.

## Executive Meeting Minutes – December 19, 2020

- 1. Meeting called to order at 6:45 PM.
- 2. Previous meeting minutes were accepted.
- 3. A financial update was given. It was noted that the finance committee has questions about the comingling of discipline and club funds. Our funds are all club funds so there is not really any co-mingling. We are concerned that there may be a misunderstanding of practices or a miscommunication. Woody would like to set a meeting with the finance committee members to clarify what they are asking for.
- 4. Past club members whose membership has expired as of October 31 must join as new members.
- 5. The New member process went well. It was effective and met our orientation and training objectives.
- 6. Lead abatement was discussed. EPA requirements need to be met. The concern is that the pistol range face is too heavily leaded and needs to be cleaned or replaced. Moving heavily leaded dirt away from the pistol range is an option, but there are some concerns. It could not be moved away from the range, because it is contaminated. We do not want members to try to do any lead abatement.
- 7. There is currently no regular meeting scheduled for the range improvement committee. A couple of members have reached out concerning the progress of range improvement.
- 8. We have had a few people ask to quit the club and receive a refund.
- 9. Members who have not completed their quiz were discussed. Members must complete the quiz before their spouse-members can receive their cards.
- 10. The board determined to hold the January regular member meeting on Tuesday the 5th as an online meeting. We will cancel the scheduled use of the Goldsby meeting hall.
- 11. Three-gun may cancel for the next few months, until ammo becomes more available.
- 12. A shotgun event is being planned.
- 13. A new load of poles was delivered. A pole was dropped at the archery range.
- 14. Hangfire articles need to be submitted immediately.
- 15. The budget came in very close to expectations.
- 16. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:30 PM.


