Safety Report

Greetings Tri City Gun Club Members, Happy Valentine's Day:

Valentine's Day Gift Ideas: For Valentine's Day think about giving your significant other a box of bullets or a new firearm instead of flowers or chocolate. This way you can go to the range together and have an enjoyable day. Assuming they will share with you.

2021 Guest Waivers: All guests must complete a new Guest Liability waiver beginning on January 1, 2021. We track and file them by calendar year.

New Steel Targets on the Long Range: We have added a new steel target and replaced a shot up one on the Long Range at Firing Points 11 and 15. These targets are to be engaged from these points only, do not crossfire. Additionally, members have asked me if they can paint the targets and my response is yes, bring your own paint and white is a good color. Makes it easy to see.

Target Placement on the Pistol Range: Members are reminded that targets must not be placed in front of the gong targets. Those benches are for gong target shooters only. Placement of paper targets in front of the steel targets can cause a ricochet.

Canceling Sportsfest and Women on Target: The Board voted in the January meeting to cancel Sportsfest in April and Women on Target in May due to Covid19 concerns. In our discussion and planning we could not find an effective way to keep members and guests safe due to the close proximity during a shooting event and the sanitizing of firearms between shooters.

Hand Thrower Area: Members, groups, and guest are responsible for picking up shells and emptying shell buckets in the blue dumpster. Break down your boxes and put in blue dumpster. Turn off lights and ceiling fan after use. Put stands and throwers back in order.



****If houses and traps are not kept cleaned after use, cords will be removed until houses, traps, and fields are detailed.**

SIGN IN UPON ARRIVAL. Note: Proper cord storage. 3' Loops, not twisted. Put all trash (hulls, boxes, etc...) in blue dumpster. If you have a group or guest, you "the member", are responsible for counts, cleanup, payment, and such.

General Meeting Minutes – January 5, 2021

1. 7:00 Meeting Called to Order. Over 40 people attended the Virtual Meeting! Went great for first try.
2. Motion to Approve Minutes of Last Meeting. Discussion ensued about when was the last meeting. Upon review of Hangfire the last Club Meeting was October 2, 2020. Motion was seconded and approved.
3. Sporting Clays: Discussion of the Sporting Clay. Proposal was displayed online.
 - a. The votes from members in attendance was unanimously yes and their votes were recorded and counted. The online vote will remain open till Friday and results will be emailed to the membership.
 - b. Tara Addressed the Method of payment. Part of the equipment purchased will allow the use of prepaid cards with a Kiosk in the Stat House to reload funds using a credit card.
 - c. The Cards count the targets and store information.
 - d. The funds will come from the 2021 budgeted Range Improvements. The Shotgun funds will be used to help pay for additional building materials for the course. Volunteers will be doing most of the work and the club has received several donations of the materials needed.
 - e. The proposal is available in the "News" online and includes the Estimated date of completion in the Fall of 2021.XXA question about Handicap access was raised. The course is about 500 yards and will allow Golf Cart or ATV access. Vehicles will be able to part along the road between the gate and the curve to access the range.

4. VOTE RESULTS: The club approved the 2021 Budget and Re-Election of Officers.
5. VICE PRESIDENT REPORT: All badges have been mailed out. Only about 60 members pending based upon Quiz or NRA Membership. The Youth Shooting Sports is continuing with great turnout. Thanks to the grants the Youth have plenty of ammo at this time. Happy to announce the Cleveland County Friends of NRA will be at the Embassy Suites June 5th, 2021. (Pending Covid).
6. QUIZ: Member discussion of the quiz. It was noted that there were some glitches but over 900 members were able to complete the quiz online. The board is reviewing another quiz for next year which will have better user feedback.
7. CRSO REPORT:
 - a. STEEL TARGETS: Ken Anderson informed the club that several of the Steel Targets have been replaced with more to come including the 150- and 200-yard targets. PLEASE DO NOT CROSSFIRE! Shoot from the appropriate benches!
8. NOTE: 19 members joined the Bright Light Monday Night Trap Shooters on January 4th. Great Turn Out!
9. NEW YEAR NEW CODE! NEW GUEST WAIVERS REQUIRED!
10. NEW MEMBERS: 80-90 New members will be joining us this year. The badges are portrait style and red. Please Encourage and Welcome our New Members!
11. TREASURER REPORT: All of the Accounting Information for 2020 has been turned into the Accountants for review. Estimate 60-90 days to complete. Woody stated that we are excited to have about 39 members on the Virtual Meeting for the majority of the meeting. Thank you for Attending!
12. Need to have raffle for next meeting! The board will evaluate how to handle!
13. Be sure to attend for a chance to win!
14. SCHEDULER REPORT: The 2021 Calendar has now been populated with events. Be sure to check the website and Hangfire before coming to the range. Reminder that some of the Club Meetings will be on Tuesdays this year due to Events or Holidays.
15. The Board will be reviewing how this meeting went and work on implementing some slide presentations for the next meeting.

Executive Meeting Minutes – January 21, 2021

1. Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM.
2. Chris Everett spoke regarding donating a handicapped parking space and a general use parking space in front of the Stathouse. He would use the same company that did the previous spaces, Frizell's Services. The purpose is to improve access to the Stathouse and shotgun ranges. We need to determine if we have sufficient handicapped parking spaces and if the parking spaces that are in place have sufficient access. Given the issue was raised, it appears that we may not have access that is sufficient to meet members' needs. Installing in the corner space between the pavilion and the Stathouse appears to be better location for the club overall. We will mark out the proposed space, get Chris's input, and will seek a bid from Frizell. We will also explore expanding the entry area to shotgun pavilion, as we are not confident that it is wide enough.
3. The next meeting's gun raffle and door prizes were discussed. We can use the Google Meet roster to assign raffle numbers for door prizes. Gun raffle tickets can be sold online using our online store.
4. The next club meeting will be held via Google Meet. We would like to continue to allow virtual access to club meetings even after we return to regular, in-person meetings. We can set up a Chrome-box on the TV in the Stathouse.
5. We had to restore QuickBooks from a backup. However, we didn't lose any data.
6. There was brief discussion over the sporting clays purchase. The machines are currently receiving maintenance prior to delivery.
7. A member raised a concern over the tone of Hangfire articles. Members are invited to help if they are able to do so.
8. The board previewed a video made by a pair of youth members who filmed part of their video at the club.
9. We appear to be at the end of our new member orientations.
10. It is time to do inventories.

11. We believe that we need to cancel our spring events. We cannot commit to doing them safely, while still being fun, or reasonable to those running or participating in the events.
12. Automation of our application, quiz results, NRA membership verification, and other item was discussed. The board is interested in this, as automation helps to improve the quality of life of the board. We can automate and control badge printing, etc...
13. Membership is still open. We would like to get up to full capacity. On January 31st, we will close membership. Afterward, we will move to half year memberships starting mid-year.
14. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 PM.

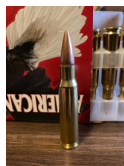

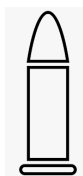
