- 3. Secretary's Report- David Barbee Elections- Re-elections are approved by popular vote. We encourage ALL members to vote! Current membership breakdown: 747 Associate members;189 Regular members= 936 total; 200 Life members; 54 Spouse members
- 4. Treasurer's Report- Woody Wood The 2021 budget was approved by popular vote.
- 5. Sporting clay purchase approved; the cost will come out of the Range Improvements budget. 2020 financials have been posted.
- 6. Range Safety Officer's Report- Ken Anderson Make sure 2021 guest waivers are filled out for all guests. New gongs on long range, lanes 12 and 15. We need a roof expert for short range. The range orientation scheduled for February 13th is cancelled due to inclement weather.
- 7. Member at Large Report- Rob Powell New members will be accepted starting June 2021.
- 8. Scheduler's Report- Tara Nelson The next General Meeting is Friday, March 5th, via Google Meet, the meeting link will be sent later. March 14th is The Luck O' the Irish Clays. April- November meetings are scheduled to meet in the Pavilion. New year, new loyalty cards are in effect: Turn in 2021 cards. Buy seven cards, get one free.
- 9. Call to Close- Mark Eriksen 2 door prize drawings- Lee Donlon and Sam Laird won. At the next meeting there will be a drawing for a K-Bar. The meeting was called to close at 7:40 PM.

Executive Meeting Minutes – February 18, 2021

- 1. Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM.
- 2. The previous meeting minutes were accepted.
- 3. The Friends of the NRA state meeting will be held in Norman, due to weather concerns.
- 4. Automation was discussed. A simplified workflow was provided for review. Applications will begin using an application period with a start date and a cut-off date. This will allow NRA credentials to be checked one time, instead of several times.
- 5. Some people have raised concerns regarding not receiving their badges. Those cases have been addressed.
- 6. An addition of a concrete pad for additional handicapped parking was discussed. A cracked section will be replaced during the installation. We will request that the slabs be reinforced to allow being driven over without breaking.
- 7. Brass sorting was discussed. A member has shown interest in having access to the brass in order to clean and resell it at gun shows. Currently members are allowed access to take what they want for personal use from the Stat-house, as the barrels are emptied each quarter. Members are encouraged to donate a dollar per pound. Ken takes the excess to be recycled. We are currently getting very little brass.
- 8. New member orientation and range tours were discussed. Some new members have not completed all of the requisite steps to be added to the roster for the orientation and range tour.
- 9. The OU trap cannot get ammo. We have a lot number 7 shot that is left over from a grant and is about five years old. We will donate five cases of 12 gauge and two cases of 20 gauge.
- 10. Board members were very satisfied with the virtual general member meeting. The PowerPoints and random drawing tool went well. We expect the March meeting to be online as well.
- 11. The meeting was adjourned at 7:11 PM.


