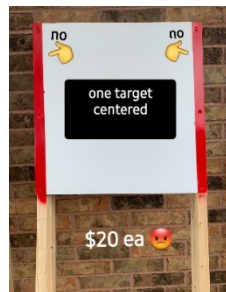
Range Maintenance

TCGC Skeet & Trap Range Etiquette

To All Youth Shooting Groups and Shotgun Key Holders:

The fields have been quite busy this year, which is a good thing. School is back and the youth groups will be practicing their shotgun skills. Here are a few rules to remember when your group is scheduled. This also pertains to member use while the groups are actively shooting.

Groups & Schedules

TCGC Youth Shooting Sports- 2nd/4th Thursday each month 6-8p
McClain Cty 4H- Every Wednesday 5-7p
OU Clay Target Team- Sundays 4-6p & Tuesdays 6p-8p year round
Norman FFA- hand thrower area-various Tuesdays & Thursdays thru October 11th 430-630p
Monday Night Lights Trap- Every Monday 7p-??
Times vary with high temps
Tuesday Night Flights Skeet- Every Tuesday 7p-??

The Rules

- scheduled groups may only occupy one field
- member hosting/coaching squad must remain on the field while squad is shooting

- maximum of 5 guns on the field at a time
- member hosting group is responsible for insuring their group is aware of TCGC safety rules
- group members not shooting must have guns in rack and remain in spectator area
- spectator areas are the patios and stat house
- member hosting group is responsible for shutdown & cleanup
 - thoroughly clean houses
 - turn off/decock/load targets
 - sign out/pay bill
 - lights out/lock up/turn off fans
 - lock stat house
- if a thrower breaks down clean up, place out of order sign on it, note in book, & call Tara before leaving range

General Meeting Minutes – September 3, 2021

Due to Technical Difficulty unable to have a meeting in September. In the Future there will be in person meetings again. The October meeting will be at the Pavilion and then meetings will move to the Goldsby Community Center for the winter months.

Executive Meeting Minutes – September 16, 2021

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.
2. The Treasurer was absent from the meeting with prior notification.
3. The previous meeting minutes were approved.
4. The Chief Range Safety Office reported that Boy Scout Camp & Shoot is still scheduled. Goldie Welch will prepare lunch. There is plenty in the budget for food. Hamburgers, hotdogs, chili, potato salad, etc. will be provided. We will provide water, but not soda.
5. A member who entered the range very early in the morning was discussed. Members will be reminded not to come onto the range during hours that it is closed.
6. Work hours performed during October were discussed. Motion made to allow work hours accrued on or after the date a member's renewal has been completed to be applied to the next membership year. Motion seconded. Motion passed with one no vote. Excess hours from previous membership years may not be rolled over in any way.
7. Discussion regarding appointed officers as related to the bylaws. An assistant treasurer, event staffing coordinator, insurance coordinator, etc. could be added. A primary goal is to spread the workload to more people. Some of the issues appear to stem from a lack of access to club data/Wild Apricot. However, the board can grant temporary, limited access to members and event coordinators as needed.
8. New member orientation was discussed. A date in December will be selected.
9. The cancelation of the club general meeting was discussed. We need to ensure that we are on the same page in the future. However, the short notice cancelation was due to technical confusion and was a onetime occurrence. The next general meeting will be held Tuesday, October 5th, at the club.
10. The Vice President Office reported that badge production will primarily be completed following renewals and will be done as a single batch.
11. A postcard will be sent out to those members who have not renewed.
12. Preparation before camp & shoot was discussed. Most prep work will be done by the club the Friday before. Key areas will be roped off.
13. Youth events are continuing to grow.
14. The Secretary reported that renewal alerts are going out and members are using the renewal system.
15. Maintenance reported that there are no major concerns.
16. The Member at Large reported that members are seeking assistance with renewal.
17. Discussion regarding the allotment of work hours was discussed. People need to actually work in order to accrue work hours. Tasks completed in one's own interest are not typically eligible to receive work hours, e.g., loading clays/targets, setting up or acting as an RSO for an event that the member is participating in, cleaning up after shooting. Board members must punch the card.
18. RSOs were discussed, as we all feel that more are needed and those that we have could be better utilized. Ken will hold a class.
19. Practical pistol/three-gun targets were discussed.
20. The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.

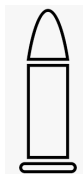
