

Hello and Happy New Year; I hope you and your family had a great Christmas Holiday. This is my first Hangfire entry as your new CRSO and I look forward to serving all of you.

First, I want to add my voice with so many others to thank Ken Anderson for his service to our Club as CRSO over the past years. I am especially appreciative of his mentorship during our change over.

Guest Waivers: as Ken noted in December Hangfire, guest waivers are to be completed once for each calendar year. So, remember to sign a new waiver the first time your guest uses the range in 2022, and place it in one of boxes on each range.

New members: We will be conducting orientation sessions for new members in January. Of course, I'll be stressing the importance of safety on ranges and reinforcing the content of our range rules. I ask for your help - when you see new members (indicated by portrait badges), take a few minutes to say hello, ask if they have any questions. Who knows, you might meet a new shooting buddy. And, as always if you see something, say something (politely of course).

I was in Academy Sports before Christmas and noticed more ammo on shelves, much of it at decent prices. No primers yet but hopefully that will improve for us reloaders. Availability of ammo will increase activity at our range, so let's watch out for each other.

Range Safety Officers: Considering above, and as mentioned during my introduction at 11/5 General Meeting, I want to encourage more visible RSO presence on ranges. 
pride in your range, clean up after yourselves, and avoid range closures.

## Executive Meeting Minutes- December 16, 2021

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.
2. The previous meeting minutes were approved.
3. Discussion regarding range security features.
4. Conducting RSO classes is being explored. We are looking at January and February dates. Class sizes would be limited, as we will be using the Stat-house. These would be all day events. There was some question regarding what is asked of the club's RSOs and what members get out of serving as an RSO. Training from the club's RSO instructors tends to be deeply discounted. The club benefits from having more RSOs in general. Active RSOs may get their RSO renewal reimbursed by the club. However, the conditions and details are not well established. Reimbursements will be further discussed at a later date.
5. New gate codes need to be shared with McClain County Sheriff, local EMS, etc... Service codes will be temporarily extended to ensure that service providers are able to access the range.
6. An email needs to be set up for the club's event planner/coordinator position, which Ken Anderson will transition to at the beginning of 2022.

7. Boy Scout Camp & Shoot and Hunter Ed will be added to the calendar.
8. Mail delivery is getting slower. Hangfire articles need to be sent out sooner in order to ensure the Hangfire is mailed in a timely manner.
9. Grant requests will go out for events. However, we have had very few events. Grants are Due January 6th.
10. Youth shotgun will have a Christmas party at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday.
11. Workday tracking was discussed.
12. Registration is open for new members. New members may only be approved if they have all of their documents, payments, etc. completed. There was some discussion regarding orientation. We will use both the range and the Goldsby community center. The community center is reserved.
13. Tara is preparing to pass the torch for Women on Target. Amber Yelton has shown interest.
14. Notification of stat-house usage was discussed. Prior notice is helpful, so that shotgun shooters and match scorers can be notified.
15. Dirt work is moving along.
16. Winterizing is getting done.
17. Brass collection was discussed. It is only rarely necessary to collect brass. Robert Powell services the live round boxes frequently. Cleaning brass from in front of the shooting line was discussed.
18. We need to ensure that we are ready to get 1099s out and tax filing completed.
19. It's time to remind folks to slow down.
20. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.


