Range Maintenance



Lots of good things are happening on the range. Lloyd Frizzell completed the maintenance area concrete pad between conexas A & B. We will soon install power outlets, fans, lighting, and workbenches. This work area will provide a clean and workable environment for maintaining and repairing equipment. Thanks to Mark Ericksen for rebuilding the short rifle berm and base. Brandon Hyde with Hyde Sand & Gravel was quick to deliver all the materials needed for this project. We highly recommend him. The long rifle range will soon get new targets installed at the 100yrd position. A big thanks to the workday crew for getting a full list of chores completed this August.

Entrance Gate Update

A new access system has been installed on the entry gate. For starters, we will continue to use the gate as we always have. The new system will be set up for different types of access. Those who use smart technology will be able to enter via an app on your phone. Some members will rent a fob to use on a yearly basis. Some members will continue to stop and manually enter a code. This new system will allow us to create one-time use codes for events and matches. This will put an end to the "open gate" during larger events. I plan to have

event/match codes ready to use beginning in September. We are currently working out the details on the back end of the software. The cool stuff is going to take more time to set up and implement, so please be patient. The answer to most of your questions is "We are working on it." Access times will be set to hours of operation.

Safety Report

Not much to report this month so I'll start with partial repeat from last month - if has been a while since you've been out to range because of heat, suggest take a few minutes to review range safety rules, refresh your memory. Rules are easy to access on TCGC website or in the red binders on each range.

Range Safety Officers for MBABR Matches: Match Director for Military Bold Action Bench Rest is hoping to improve flow of shooters through monthly matches. To do so needs a few more RSO volunteers. This will be a great opportunity to learn and practice specific range procedures and commands for the course of fire. And a reminder – dedicated RSOs (i.e. not shooting) earn volunteer work hours. Please contact Steve Dyer, Match Director at mbabr@tcgc.us or CRSO if you are interested.

When you are out enjoying your range, please do so safely by shooting straight, placing targets at a height so that bullets impact the lower 2/3rds of the backstop and don't hit the sticks. Use and be aware of the red lights. Always be deliberate in your actions with firearms.

3. Bob Powell reported that he received a letter from the ORA. ORA is considering folding. There will be a meeting on 8-20-22 at the Bethel Acres Community Center. New officers will be elected at this meeting.
4. The Chief Range Safety Office reported the range is quiet due to the heat.
5. If you see someone who doesn't belong, ask for their badge. However, please don't put yourself in a bad spot, ask for help where needed.
6. The Vice President Office reported that it's been very hot!!!! Turnout has been light for the youth events due to the heat.
7. The scholarship for college or trade school is up on the website. It is due 8-31-22.
8. YHEC was canceled due to low enrollment.
9. Raffle tickets for the Fostech are on sale now for \$20 for 1, \$50 for 3, and \$100 for 5.
10. The Secretary reported that renewals are coming up in October. Dues are going up \$20 per year. Keep an eye on the Hangfire for more updates. If you have any questions about memberships or upgrades, please contact David Barbee.

The outgoing keypad has been removed.

11. We still need to get procedures for tomahawks and need to order standard tomahawks.

12. We will be moving forward with electronic waivers in the near future.
13. The Treasurer asks that the club move to using Arvest bank for regular banking, investment services, etc... P-Card is a service that is offered that, due to its high level of control, may be beneficial to the club. A motion to move to using banking services at Arvest was made and seconded. The TCGC board passed a motion to open accounts/corporate credit card accounts with Arvest Bank. Signers for accounts will be: a) President - Mark Ericksen b) Secretary - David Barbee c) Treasurer - Terrance "Woody" Wood.
14. The bylaws need to be updated on the website.
15. The Member at Large has not received any complaints this month.
16. Hunter Education registrations are at 14. All registrations are completed online. Waivers were discussed. If we have access to email addresses, we will send waivers out in advance. If not, waivers will be signed on site. The registration process will be sent to all attendees. A pole will be placed in the ground, so that a tree stand can be put up. A fence will be set up to practice crossing a fence line.
17. Other upcoming events were discussed.
18. The new keypads serve as readers and will work with an app, badges, and/or fobs. We will continue to use the keypad for the foreseeable future. New technology will be announced as it is implemented.
19. The OU shotgun club was discussed. We need to find good contacts again.
20. The meeting was adjourned at 8:06 p.m.

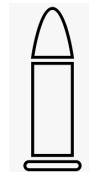
