President's Report

TCGC Members

It is nice to be in the fall with cooler weather. The new target holders that have been implemented will help keep repairs to a minimum. A big AT-A-BOY to the members that worked so hard and fast to build and install them. I'm sure we will be seeing more of their work projects in the future. It sure is nice now that the renewals have been streamlined. This has been an ongoing process that will continue to improve, Thank you! to all of those involved with this over the years. We are planning on some dirt removal at the target location on the 200yd berm. This will allow more paper targets in that location.

For those that want to shoot at 1000 YARDS!!!!!! at TCGC, this takes a little work and thinking, record the muzzle velocity of your rifle using the round you want to shoot at 1000 yds. Go to a Ballistic Calculator on line and input all of the information: Bullet Ballistic Coefficient , Bullet Weight , Muzzle Velocity from a chronograph and YOUR rifle, not off the box of ammo , Max Range- 1000yds, Interval- 50yds, Drag Function , Site Height- 1.5", Shooting angle- 0, Zero Range- 50yds, Wind speed- 0, Wind Angle (Deg)- 0, Altitude _____, Pressure- _____, Temperature- ____, Humidity- ____ This will give you a chart, showing the drop of the bullet AT every 50yds out to 1000yds. The 200 yd range is the only range you will be able to do this at because you will be aiming + - twenty feet BELOW the 200 vd target. My chart shows a 194.9" drop at 1000 yds and a 4.5" drop at 200 yds. 194.9 minus 4.5 equals 190.4 equals 15.87 feet to aim below the target. You will need a quality scope that will adjust 25 MOA or 7 MILS. I would adjust my scope with a "come up" of 18.6 MOA and then aim 15.87' below the 200 yd target. If you use all the correct variables from where you will be shooting, you can trust the calculator. It is always the unknown that is the problem.

<u>General Meeting Minutes – October 7, 2022</u>

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Mark Ericksen.
- 2. The previous meeting minutes were approved.
- 3. The Vice President reported that we have a lot of kids coming for the Youth Shoot. We need extra volunteers, especially RSOs. Over 20 kids will be there. Ladies fun shoot is on Sunday at the Oklahoma City Gun Club. The raffle tickets are \$20 for 1 ticket, and \$50 for 5 tickets. The club received a \$5,000 grant to help with handicap parking.
- 4. The Secretary discussed renewals; you will be getting an email soon with information about the upcoming renewal process. Nominations for the board are open. The elections are in November.
- 5. The Treasurer reported that as we start the renewals, the board is finalizing the 2023 budget. If there are any items that need added to the budget, please let us know.
- 6. The Scheduler reported that we have brought in a lot of new dirt. Please don't shoot into the dirt piles. We also received donated backing material. October 8th is the MBABR State match. There are 4 teams. The last workday for your 2022 discount is next weekend.
- 7. The Member at Large reported that there are a lot of people asking to join the club and about renewals.

- 8. Maintenance reported that we have a lot of projects going on with the dirt. Please be patient if you see us on the range with the tractor.
- 9. Simm Rudnick reported that this year the wildlife department is allowing you to use your air bow during hunting season, but not during archery season.
- 10. Ken Anderson reported that September was a busy month for us! We had Hunters Ed and Camp and Shoot. We couldn't do it without you!

11. The meeting was adjourned at 7:17 pm.

<u>Officer Meeting Minutes – October 20, 2022</u>

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Meeting began late to accommodate a Hungry-Hungry-Recorder.
- 2. The previous meeting minutes were approved.
- 3. Wayne Bachman spoke regarding the club hosting a demonstration shooter, such as Doug Fuller. He would be willing to cover half the cost if the club is willing to find someone and cover the remaining costs. This would be a great feature for a family-day event. A range would need to be closed and a dedicated spectator area designated to accommodate a demonstration of this nature.
- 4. Renewals were discussed. There were very few legitimate issues reported with either the test or the renewal process. It was noted that the NRA number verification is done manually, so it could take a little bit of time for it to be processed. Three members present at the meeting reported that the entire renewal process, including uploading NRA credentials, taking the test, and paying, took less than 15-minutes. Members need to be reminded that they need to get their work hours in before they pay. Members also need to be reminded that payment is the final step in the renewal process; all other steps must be completed first, without exception.
- 5. A shooter used buckshot and slugs on the shotgun range and mistook a thrower cover for the patterning board. The shooter recognized his error, brought it to light, and offered to repair any damage. However, this issue does spotlight the concern that many shooters are unclear about the use of the patterning board.
- 6. There was some discussion about behavioral expectations of groups that use the range.
- 7. There is some interest in better communication of range closings and openings. These are already on the calendar. Some members want more granular, up to the minute information. We don't have reasonable means to do this at the moment.
- 8. Bulk purchasing of primers and other reloading supplies was discussed. The club cannot do this, but members could organize a purchasing group.
- 9. It was noted that guests at events must be appropriately instructed and supervised.
- 10. A motion was made to require new shooter orientation consisting of safety training and instruction appropriate to any guidelines held by the governing bodies of the discipline in question to be provided at all events held at TCGC. The motion was seconded and approved.
- 11. The upcoming bank account change and tasks to be completed during the change were discussed.
- 12. The club will be moving to using electronic waivers. Paper waiver forms will be discontinued once online waivers have been implemented. The club will provide tablets or other devices to accommodate users.
- 13. Grants were discussed. Funding for additional handicapped parking spaces were received.
- 14. The budget will be provided to the board and the finance committee. The club will be providing more money to youth events to make up for reduced grant funding from the NRA.
- 15. 70% of members have renewed.
- 16. A new laptop has been purchased for the secretary.
- 17. Amber Yelton has been made the assistant/co-recorder. She has been doing this task for some time. This is official recognition.
- 18. Members will only be issued one badge when they join the club. The year that the member joined will not be included on the badge, as year joined is not relevant. Consecutive years of membership does matter and will be noted on the member profile. The member ID could be included on the card, but the NRA number probably would not be included. We will not include credentials that expire. Special badges can be printed as needed, such as when changing membership levels.
- 19. Badges will be available at general membership meetings. The badges will not be mailed out.

- 20. Next year's gate codes will be issued to members monthly. Monthly gate codes will have a short period of overlap. Monthly gate codes will be a step toward rolling membership. Gate codes do not affect the use of app or fob entries.
- 21. Elections are due. Nobody is running opposed. An electronic ballot will be run to approve the existing board members being retained.
- 22. The accountant is working on the 990s.
- 23. There was some discussion regarding sponsoring competitive youth teams.
- 24. Discussion regarding allowing retired police officers to do qualifying shoots for carry reciprocity at the club. This could be hosted as a private event or even as individual guests.
- 25. Camp & shoot went really well. New tomahawks are in, and tomahawks went really well.
- 26. FFA shoot is done and went well.
- 27. Another RSO class is under consideration.
- 28. The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 pm.
