- 1. Called to order
- 2. Quorum present
- 3. Renewals were discussed. Renewals went really well. Members were reminded by the President that missing renewals results in being required to rejoin as a new member and pay the \$125 initiation fee
- 4. The 2023 budget was approved
- 5. The Member at Large announced no new business to discuss from the membership
- 6. Jamie Schmidt was reelected as Vice President
- 7. Tara Nelson was reelected as Scheduler
- 8. David Barbee was reelected as Secretary
- 9. Nominations were taken for the Finance Committee. The following members were nominated and approved: Ralph Snyder, Simm Rudnik, Gary Beebe, James Wilbanks. These four (plus the club president ex-officio) constitute the Finance Committee moving forward.
- 10. The CRSO announced no safety items to discuss
- 11. The scheduler asked if anybody likes meetings on Tuesday. The club is meeting more involved with the Appleseed Project. More Appleseed shoots are being scheduled, a ladies-focused Appleseed event is being planned, and a pistol Appleseed is possible for next year. - 12. Maintenance reminded the membership to put one and only one target in the middle of a target backer. You agreed to this in the range rules. Put your target backer back in the storage area when you're done.
- 13. Meeting adjourned

Officer Meeting Minutes – December 15, 2022

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm.
- 2. The previous meeting minutes were approved.
- 3. Event planning for 2023 was discussed. Online registration and payment will continue to be used. Coordinating the limitation on handgun and .50 bmg for Boy Scout troops that attend Sportsfest was noted as a concern. However, it appears to not have created much of a problem. We will leave the details of managing the scouts to the event coordinators.
- 4. Ladies Day/Women on Target is scheduled.
- 5. New batteries were purchased for the AED, one to install in the AED, and one to keep as a spare. These batteries last at least one year in the AED and have a five-year shelf life if they have not been installed.
- 6. Youth sports night has continued to have very good turnout. Additional shotgun rounds are necessary, as more youth are shooting.
- 7. We may need to begin cycling out the muzzle loaders and air rifles. They are getting old and parts are getting hard to get.
- 8. We will do the Fostech rifle drawing at the next general meeting.
- 9. Grants have been submitted. We are seeking additional grant funding.
- 10. We will only have a New Year's party at the general meeting if members commit to actually stay and clean up.
- 11. Our badge printing resources are strained. The printer/computer setup is slow, but it works. It was noted that, "Badges? We don't need no stinkin' badges!"
- 12. We would like to get a sign with a QR code linking to the member gate code link: tcgc.us\code.
- 13. We need a new steel bollard to place in front of the keypad at the gate.
- 14. The tractor is away for service and will not be back until January.
- 15. Members need to pick up their badges at meetings. It was noted that this year's badges are permanent badges. The members will not need to get it replaced. Thus, they only need to come to one meeting.
- 16. We will hold virtual meetings if there is inclement weather. We have had good success with those in the past.
- 17. Appleseed is going to do a closed team building exercise on the 14th of January. This event is not open to the public.
- 18. There is a solid day's work necessary to get the bank information updated.
- 19. The meeting was adjourned at 7:53 pm.


