Vice President's Report

Bylaw Change! Please Vote Yes!

Bylaw Amendment that changes membership start and end dates to be the date that the member joined the club (instead of every membership being January and ending in December) and makes renewals due one year after joining the club (instead of October of every year).

This eliminates confusion caused by renewals being due in October even though memberships don't end until December. This also makes renewals and opening up for new members easier to manage which will contribute to the mission of our club to grow the shooting sports.

Section 3.01 will be changed to read as follows:

Section 3.01. ELIGIBILITY. Any citizen or legal resident of the United States twenty-one (21) years of age or older, legally able to handle firearms, and a member of the National Rifle Association (NRA) may become a member of this organization after meeting all of the following conditions: a) passing the administrative and safety rules quiz as determined by the board, b) completing a Range & Safety Orientation, c) paying the current initiation fees and dues established by the board, and d) subscribing to the following pledge, to-wit: [pledge remains unchanged]

Section 3.012 will be changed to read as follows:

Section 3.012. TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP. Memberships shall be valid for one (1) year (a) beginning on the effective date of membership (join date) noted in the member's membership record or (b) beginning on the anniversary of the join date. Membership requires the individual member (a) complete and submit an application for membership or renewal, as designated by the board, (b) demonstrate understanding of TCGC administrative and safety rules, and c) pay any dues and fees required within one (1) month of their join date or for subsequent years of membership, within one (1) month the anniversary of the member's join date. Failure to complete the membership requirements will result in the termination of membership. Former members, other than life members, must apply as a "New Member."

Section 3.013 will be deleted; its contents have been incorporated into 3.0

Safety Report

Nothing specific to report this month so thought I'd write a few thoughts, prompted by recent discussions with RSOs.

Safety Observations: Our Club relies on all of us working together to keep our ranges safe. If we see something, say something. My own attitude about safety whether on a range, officiating at a Match, or in a workplace, has been that I would feel bad if did not speak up and someone was later hurt in any way. For those of us who are NRA Certified RSOs, wearing the hat or badge shows our commitment to act if see safety issues. When giving feedback, be polite - I've found it best to provide constructive feedback about the observation, never aimed at the person. For example, after calling for cease fire if necessary, introduce yourself and use words such as "I noticed this ..." rather than "I saw you do this". If the observation is for Guests of a Member, be sure to include that Member in the discussion because we are responsible for our Guests. If you should ever receive feedback, think about the reason, don't feel threatened, and accept the feedback gracefully. If feedback results in conflict or "debate" about our Range Rules, I invite either Member to call or email me per below.

As always - when you are out enjoying your range, please do so safely. Always heed the red lights, and always be deliberate in your actions with firearms. If you ever have any questions, issues or concerns about safety at our range feel free to contact me.


