Modification for the Wizard Drill could be shoot from compressed ready. (A good way to practice drawing from concealment is with unloaded firearm at home) Good Shooting!

Safety Report

Hope you've been out enjoying some safe shooting time. Summer heat is here, so a reminder to keep yourself and any guests hydrated. The Stat House always has water and is an easy way to take a break from heat.

First Aid/CPR/AED Training with FAST (First Aid for Severe Trauma): You may recall that we had set a target for training and certification of members. I am excited to announce that one of our members, Wes Tebo, has offered to train and that the Board has set a budget for the cost of certifications. Wes is an American Red Cross Instructor for First Aid, CPR and AED (he is also Wilderness and Remote First Aid Instructor, not including that in our Club course).

I especially encourage our RSOs to get certified or update your expired certification (I will be doing exactly that). An extra note for Match Directors – please consider taking the course if you are not certified or it has expired, and please also encourage any of your regular shooters to get certified so that we can increase likelihood of having help at matches should they ever be needed.

Current curriculum allows for an online component that will need to be done before any course, so the in person session will only be about 3 hours in the Stat House. Please email me if you are interested and can dedicate some time to get certified and tell me any preferences for weeknight or weekend. I will build a list, set a schedule with Wes, and distribute to all who express interest.

As always - when you are out enjoying your range, please do so safely. Always heed the red lights, and always be deliberate in your actions with firearms. If you ever have any questions, issues or concerns about safety at our range feel free to contact me.

- pistol & short-range targets should be removed from shooting range and placed in target area after use.

Oklahoma Governor Signed Two Important Second Amendment Bills: Boat Carry and Constitutional Carry Cleanup



Recently, Governor Kevin Stitt, signed two important pieces of legislation that uphold our Second Amendment rights.

Firstly, <u>Senate Bill 978</u>, also known as the Boat Carry Bill, has been signed into law. This bill recognizes individuals right to carry a firearm on a boat as long as they are legally allowed to possess a firearm. This is a significant victory for those who enjoy recreational boating and want to exercise their right to self-defense.

Secondly, <u>House Bill 1789</u>, also known as the Constitutional Carry Cleanup Bill, has been signed into law. This bill clarifies language in the existing constitutional carry law and ensures that law-abiding citizens can carry a firearm without unnecessary government permission slips. This is crucial in protecting our Second Amendment rights and ensuring that law-abiding citizens are not unjustly prosecuted for exercising their right to bear arms.

NRA applauds Governor Stitt and the Oklahoma Legislature for taking bold steps to protect our Second Amendment rights. These new laws are a victory for all Oklahomans who believe in the fundamental right to self-defense and the right to bear arms.

Military Bolt Action Sniper Rifle Match Update (Corrected)

Shooters,

There has been interest in setting up a Military Bolt Action match for scoped WWI - WW2 sniper rifles. To get things rolling, we'll have a combined regular Mil Bolt and Mil Sniper match in August, scored separately like the SMLE and Winter War matches.

To keep the integrity and spirit of the Mil Bolt matches, we'll set basic guidelines for rifles and scopes, see how things turn out in August and adjust as necessary until we reach a good blend of historical authenticity and reasonable access to the match for common Mil Bolt rifles.

Rules for Military Sniper:

- 1. Limited to pre-WWI WWI WW2 military issue bolt action sniper rifles, replicas, and as-issued military bolt action rifles fitted with scopes of 4X or less. This is not the match for later heavy barrel .308 sniper rifles, "sporter-ized" military rifles or target scopes.
- 2. Replica sniper rifle reproductions that are manufactured to be identical to military issue sniper rifles can be used, regardless of manufacture date.
- 3. Mil bolt rifles with scopes mounted but otherwise as issued can be used.
- 4. As long eye relief scope mounts are available that fit into rear sight bases of several models of mil bolt guns, rifles scoped with these can be used. Again, scopes are limited to 4X or less and the rifles should be otherwise as issued.

We'll run this first match to sort through issues and address feedback before working with the club to announce the matches and set a schedule. Contact me directly if you have questions.




