Range Maintenance

The contractors (B&H Construction) that have occupied our range for the past several weeks (installing communications lines) should be finishing up operations at or near our property very soon. Those that witnessed all the mishaps at the gate, will be happy to know, a new gate will be installed soon.

Three new 25yrd berms will be built on the long range in the very near future. We are in the process of purchasing the right dirt to do the job. Short Rifle Range new targets will be designed and built in the very near future.

Sign up for workday, projects, or event prep. Make friends while getting much needed chores and projects completed. Just let maintenance know if you have time or skills to contribute.

Some skills needed are spraying (herbicides), carpentry, concrete and masonry, electrical, and plumbing.

A few reminders to help keep your range awesome:

- Speed Limit is 10mph or less.
- 1 target centered on pistol & short rifle range targets.
- Shot size allowed on shotgun ranges (and pattern board) is 7 ½, 7 steel, 8, 9. Larger shot sizes (6, 4, 2, buckshot, & slugs are only allowed on Long Range
- pistol & short-range targets should be removed from shooting range and placed in target area after use.

<u>General Meeting Minutes – October 3, 2023</u>

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.
- 2. The previous meeting minutes were approved.
- 3. The Chief Range Safety Office reported that he is happy to see everyone here. We have completed three CPR and first aid courses with a total of 35 members who are now certified. We previously suspended the practical pistol match; it has been renewed. We had a few members. volunteer to be RSOs at this event. Everything went well on Sunday. We are going to be asking other discipline directors to jump on board with the new guidelines.
- 4. The Vice President Office reported that she is excited that the youth Glock league has really taken off. We have seven youths that have committed to participate in the match at the end of the month. We are auctioning off a Henry 44 Remington Magnum to support the youth tonight! It's from the Friends of NRA Banquet. We might do an online auction. We had a youth shoot his first 25 in a row on trap.
- 5. The Scheduler reported we started testing the new membership portal. Renewals will start in a few weeks, probably three to four weeks. When life renewal paperwork is turned in, you will be upgraded. Goldsby Community Center will be the location of the meetings for November, December, January, and February. There will be a few dates for in person renewals. November 6th is one of the dates. For

- shotgun, this should be the last week there are workers on the shotgun range. Also, do not worry, the gate will be rebuilt as soon as the work on the shotgun range is complete.
- 6. Ken Anderson reported that we have had the Norman FFA out shooting and getting ready for their next match. Camp and Shoot on October 14th. We have about 90 kids registered, and 70 members signed up to volunteer. We need help with tomahawk, 22 rifle, and muzzleloader. There will also be a lunar eclipse that day. We did Hunter Ed in September. We had 40 kids get their registration.
- 7. The Member at Large reported that there are a lot of people. asking about joining the club and renewals, we are waiting on the portal to open.
- 8. Archery reported that we have 3D targets on lanes 1-10. Please do not use broadhead arrows on these targets.
- 9. Steve Dyer said that we have soil that has been brought in on the 25-yard berms. There will be more soil coming soon. We would like the berms to be at least four feet high. We are also looking for recommendations on how thick to make the berms.
- 10. Mike Whittaker reported that Bright Lights has been changed to 8:00 in the AM. We will go back to our regular time in November. The nominating committee for shotgun could not get anyone to run against the current people who hold board positions. Please let us know if you would like to run for office. Charles Kliewer will be running for the office of Member at Large.
- 11. We will have new black powder guns for camp and shoot.
- 12. The meeting was adjourned at 7:27 p.m.

Officer Meeting Minutes – October 19, 2023

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.
- 2. The previous meeting minutes were approved.
- 3. New member application is being tested and should be completed very soon. Current member renewal dates are set to December 31st. A few members were able to do portions of their renewals but should not have been able to do so. There have been some folks that were unclear about when they need to renew. They are being provided guidance that current member renewal dates are set to December 31st. They will be contacted. An email blast will go out to the membership to clarify and remind them of the change.
- 4. FFA sporting clays is coming up. If it is raining, they will park on the East side of the road. If it is dry, they can park in the camping area.
- 5. Camp & Shoot went well. Lots of positive feedback. There was an incident with the gate where an attendee who did not have the code forced the gate open. The gate will be repaired. There was an additional incident later in the day. An after-action review will be conducted.
- 6. Event staff needs to be prepared to draw event leaders and supervisors in to help manage event attendees.
- 7. There was a minor, self-inflicted, accidental injury on the archery range.
- 8. Practical pistol matches are back on. TCGC discipline rules are being observed and are working well. A second RO seminar is scheduled.
- 9. The Finance Committee requests that the board review the financials of practical pistol and report to the board.
- 10. The club has raised over \$1000 for the Glock Team. They have TCGC shirts.
- 11. We need to do the invoicing for youth and other group ammo.
- 12. Air guns are working fine. Reported problems were user error.
- 13. There's still money in the bank.
- 14. The meeting was adjourned at 7:06 p.m.




